## How to find the venue

The map below shows the main places of interest: 1, 3 and 5: accommodation places, 2: the university campus, \_\_: the restaurant where we will have the dinner.

**1** is Haus Providentia, can be reached with bus line 5, 15 (“Kirmesplatz”) and 20 (“Neugasse”)

**2** is the university campus, can be reached by bus lines 3, 5 and 20 (3, 20: “Winner Straße”, 5: “Oberweiher UNI”).

**3** is the Hotel Fährrhaus am Stausee, bus 3 or 20 until “Winner Straße”.

**4** is the restaurant Weinhaus Schwaab where we will have dinner (see <http://www.weinkeller-schwaab.de/weinhaus.html>, sorry, only in German)

**5** is the Hotel Kreuter, bus 3 until “Güls Moselbrücke”
